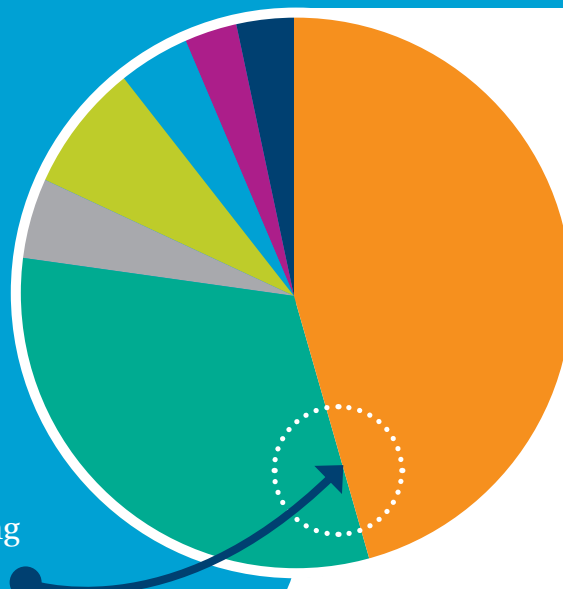


Thanks to gifts from more than 12,000 donors, our Foundation granted over \$7.2 million to St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton, its three campuses and offsite care facilities.

The vast amount of funds granted were to help the Hospital purchase equipment, renovate patient care areas, and fund healthcare research studies. That's because these three vital areas are not always funded by the operating dollars St. Joe's receives from the government.

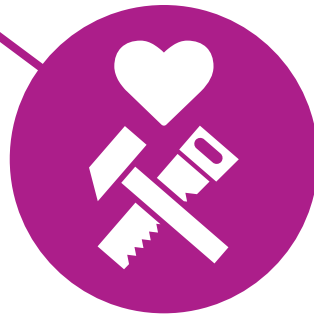

- Translation services for patient materials for inclusive, culturally sensitive care and so much more

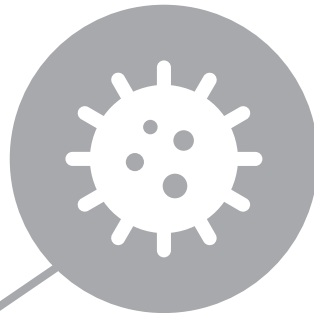


5 Renovations to Patient Care Areas

- iPads to keep patients connected to loved ones when visitors were not permitted in Hospital
- Pandemic-related renovations to the ICU
- ECG and Oximetry Monitors for COVID-19 Unit
- EEG for Diagnostic Imaging
- Mobile Ultrasound and Intubation Kits for the Emergency Room



\$500,000+ for Mental Health Programs

- Funding the continued operation of a mobile mental health van to serve our most vulnerable patients in their communities
- Sustaining funds for a dedicated intake worker for mental health support for healthcare workers and first responders
- Piloted a program to address substance use in young adults
- Funded the expansion of services at our Youth Wellness Centre including programs specifically for BIPOC and LGBTQ2SI+ youth



\$273,000 Invested in Supporting St. Joe's Staff

Healthcare workers have put in Herculean efforts over the past two and a half years as they cared for our community amidst a global pandemic. But that kind of pressure and uncertainty takes a toll, that's why our Foundation was pleased to provide funding for:

- Wellbeats – an online & on-demand fitness and wellness program free for Hospital staff
- 752 COVID-19 care packages for staff who contracted the virus and were unable to work
- 70 Education grants and fellowships to help healthcare workers enhance their skills
- Care carts, nutrition provision, staff recognition and appreciation initiatives



442 Robotic Surgeries Completed

- 260 were for prostate, bladder or urological cancers
- 110 were for cancers of the head, neck, lungs or chest
- 71 of the robotic surgeries were full or partial knee replacements
- 1 new robotic procedure developed for cancer of the esophagus
