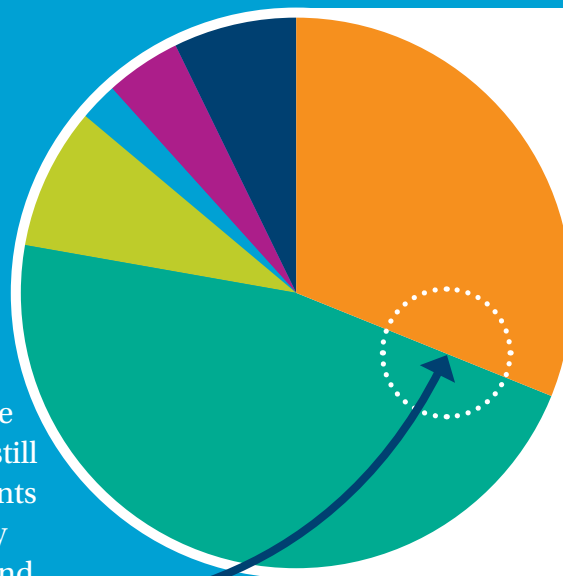

The vast amount of funds granted were to help the Hospital purchase equipment, renovate patient care areas, and fund healthcare research studies, while still more funds were used to bring comfort to the patients we serve. Donations from our generous community help to bridge the gap and fund essential projects and programs that are not covered by operating dollars St. Joe's receives from the government.

- More than 26 different research studies were supported this year
- Just a few of the fields of study include: Innovations in Mental Health and Addictions Care for Women, Youth, Racialized Populations and Seniors; new treatment options for Obsessive Compulsive Disorder, Advancements in Cancer Diagnosis, Surgery and Care, the impact of Long COVID and more.

5 Renovations to Patient Care Areas

- Renewal and renovation of two palliative care suites
- Continued funding for the expansion of the Emergency Mental Health Service
- Zoom Conferencing Room for COVID-19 Unit
- Installation of Handrails in Several Units for Patient Safety
- Furniture for the Family Area of the Birthing Unit

\$580,000 for Mental Health & Addictions Care

- Continuing our support for a mobile mental health unit that brings care out of the Hospital and into the neighbourhoods of our most vulnerable patients
- Funding the addition of an Occupational Therapist in our Schizophrenia Community Integration Service to help clients transition back into employment following care
- Piloting a program aimed at addressing addiction in youth early on, before it becomes a lifelong battle
- Creating empowerment grants that help clients to achieve their personal recovery goals

480 Robotic Surgeries Completed

- 258 for prostate or urologic cancers
- 112 full or partial knee replacements
- 110 for cancers of the chest, head and neck
